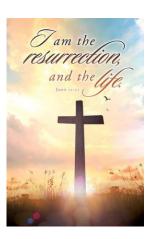

Dear Friends

Welcome to worship.

First – The Link Café is to reopen from 1 June 2019. We have taken time – 3 months – to consider input from members of the congregation (both made in writing or in person). The main concerns were that the Link should reopen, that it should be used as a means of outreach to those who don't come to church, and that it be a benefit to our members. Also, that it should not be a financial drain on the Church. On Saturday 18 May, the Council approved a proposal by Patrick and Lucrecia Bettesworth. We look forward to what they have to offer and, of course, I trust we will be patient with them as this is a new venture for them as well. On Sundays, we will continue to see our volunteers serving tea and coffee. We don't want to see this done away with as it is a wonderful opportunity for us to serve one another.

Second – We are in the process of selecting a new half-day Church Administrator to run the administrative side of the Church office. This position is modelled on the role designed by Council previously and duties which were previously undertaken by Veronica Swanepoel. The role has been thoroughly revised and fitted to a half day. We hope to have someone in place by Monday 3 June. It has been a tremendous strain working without any "back room" administrative assistance since 1 February 2019 and will a relief to have a responsible person in place.

We are so grateful to the volunteer receptionists who have assisted us since Denise went off sick in February and we continue to be grateful for your help. The Council has begun discussing how reception will be staffed in the future with the limited resources available to us. Over the next few months.

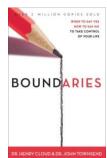
