Today we start a new series here at SWUC. This series, called "a Church in the neighbourhood" is driven by the vision I articulated at Vision Night in March. It is built on the premise that you and I are called to be Jesus' disciples just as the first disciples were called (Luke 5, Matt 4) and that we have been 'sent' just as they were (Matt 28: 19 & 20). The problem is that we're not 'Go-ing' anymore.


