Dear Friends

Welcome to worship.

Last Sunday afternoon, Sascha and I spent under blankets on the couch and glued to the TV. What an incredible afternoon it was for sport. We kept flicking between the World Cup cricket final between England and New Zealand which ended in such a dramatic “super over” and the tennis which went on for four hours between Rodger Federer and Novak Djokovic. At some points I was at the edge of my seat, sometimes shaking my head. There were moans and cries. It was all spell binding, an emotional rollercoaster.

In the middle of the week came the sad news of the death of Johnnie Clegg, anthropologist and singer who helped us bridge the gap between white western and African culture. In his songs, Clegg showed how we could feel our African identity in the rhythm and words of the African song. His music broke down barriers. His moving tribute to Nelson Mandela, Asimbonanga, sung by a Woolworths “flash mob” brought tears in the days after Mandela’s death. Nelson Mandela would have been 101 on Thursday. I give thanks to God for Good people who help us appreciate each other.

There is so much beautiful about life, so many beautiful people, moments. I give thanks to God for all he has allowed us to enjoy. Our faith in Christ, our way of life can bring us so much joy. We should enjoy following Jesus.


